Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy describes how Interpose MGA LLC ("Interpose," "we," "us," or "our") collects, uses, discloses, and retains information in connection with the services made available through interposegroup.com and any associated portals, dashboards, applications, or other online services (collectively, the "Services").

2. Information We Collect

We may collect information you provide directly to us, including name, email address, phone number, company name, business affiliation, account credentials, licensing or certification information, correspondence, and information submitted through forms, portals, applications, or other service interactions.

We may also collect information automatically when the Services are used, including IP address, browser type, device information, referring pages, pages viewed, access times, and similar usage information. We may use cookies or similar technologies for these purposes.

3. How We Use Information

We may use information to:

- (a) provide, operate, maintain, and improve the Services;
- (b) review submissions, administer accounts, and support insurance-related operations;
- (c) communicate regarding the Services, including operational notices, support, and service updates;
- (d) monitor, secure, and protect the Services and our systems;
- (e) comply with legal, regulatory, contractual, audit, recordkeeping, and enforcement obligations; and
- (f) establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.

4. Information Sharing

We may disclose information:

- (a) to vendors, service providers, and contractors performing services on our behalf;

- (b) to carriers, reinsurers, brokers, administrators, and other counterparties where relevant to the services being provided;
- (c) to professional advisers, including legal, compliance, accounting, and audit advisers;
- (d) where required by law, regulation, legal process, or governmental request; and
- (e) in connection with an actual or proposed merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, sale of assets, or similar corporate transaction.

We do not disclose personal information except as described in this Privacy Policy or as otherwise permitted or required by law.

5. Data Retention

We retain information for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy and as required or permitted by applicable law, regulation, contractual obligation, audit requirement, claims handling need, record retention policy, or internal administrative purpose. Retention periods may vary depending on the nature of the information, the service involved, and the legal or operational context in which the information was collected.

6. De-Identified or Aggregated Information

We may use and disclose information that has been de-identified or aggregated so that it does not reasonably identify an individual.

7. Security

We maintain administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect information against unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure. No system or method of transmission or storage is fully secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

8. Your Choices

Subject to applicable law, you may request access to, correction of, or updates to certain account information by contacting us. You may opt out of non-essential promotional communications by using the unsubscribe mechanism in those communications. We may retain information as required for legal, regulatory, audit, security, recordkeeping, or legitimate business purposes.

9. Third-Party Services

The Services may contain links to, or integrations with, third-party websites, platforms, portals, or services. Interpose is not responsible for the privacy, security, content, or information practices of those third parties, and the information practices of such third parties are governed by their own terms and policies.

10. Children's Privacy

The Services are not directed to children under 18, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children through the Services. If we become aware that we have collected personal information from a child, we will delete such information as required by applicable law.
